

Seapig Seaglass Drilling Workshops

In all of the workshops you will be introduced to the set-up, equipment and techniques needed to drill seaglass, and you will have plenty of opportunity to learn and practise this new skill! All workshops also include refreshments of hot and cold drinks and nibbles.



Make a Seaglass Pendant

After some practise you will select a piece of seaglass and make this into a pendant to take home with you. There will be a range of sterling silver findings and chain lengths to choose from.

You are welcome to use seaglass that we provide or to use a piece that you have collected yourself.

£50 per person approx. 1.5-2 hours



Make a Pair of Seaglass Earrings

After some practise you will select two pieces of similar seaglass and make into a pair of earrings to take home with you. There will be a range of sterling silver and 14k filled gold findings so that you can choose your favourite style of earrings

You are welcome to use seaglass that we provide or to use pieces that you have collected yourself.

£55 per person approx. 2 hours



Make a Seaglass Leather Bracelet

After some practise you will select several pieces of seaglass and make these into a triple-wrap leather bracelet (also doubles as a necklace) to take home with you.

You are welcome to use seaglass that we provide or to use pieces that you have collected yourself, or a combination of the two.

£60 per person approx. 2.25 hours



Make a Seaglass Pendant and Earrings

After some practise you will select several pieces of seaglass and make these into a pendant and a pair of earrings to take home with you.

There will be a range of silver findings and chain lengths to choose from.

You are welcome to use seaglass that we provide or to use pieces that you have collected yourself, or a combination of the two.

The pendant and earrings can either be made as a 'set' or as two individual pieces.

£70 per person approx. 2.5 hours

Two-piece creative workshop

These workshops are geared more towards those who have a collection of their own seaglass and would like some guidance and creative help in what to make out of it. You will receive the same introduction to drilling as with the other workshops, and then we will spend time looking through your own glass and deciding what it lends itself to for making.

There is more choice in these workshops about what you can create, and due to this, the group sizes are smaller at max 4 persons.

Although these workshops are designed to make use of your own glass, our glass will be available if you need any pieces to fill in any gaps!

£100 per person approx. 2.5-3 hours
